<b>Dog Agility Confidence Course</b>	4 weeks	\$55	6	None	2/15/12 @ 7:45pm	10 weeks old and up	For “testing” your puppy or dog to see if it would like agility. For building confidence in fearful dogs. Basic obstacles will be gradually introduce including tunnel, chute, table, A-frame and dogwalk,
<b>Foundation &amp; Groundwork for Dog Agility</b>	8 weeks	\$100	6	None	7/12/12 @ 7:45pm	16 weeks old and up	Focus on building focus, attention, off leash handling, & motivation for agility. The course will teach you and your dog a “system” you will use for running sequences of agility obstacles before starting obstacle training.
<b>Jump Training</b>	6 weeks	\$85	6	Foundation & Groundwork	7/12/12 @ 6:30pm	1 year and up	Teaches jumping skills to the dogs, including jump lanes, and common patterns and jump drills for agility.
<b>Contact &amp; Weave Pole Training Class</b>	6 weeks	\$85	6	Foundation & Groundwork	3/15/12 @ 6:30pm	1 year and up	Goal of this course is to teach dogs *independent* and *reliable* performance of all contact obstacles (table, A-Frame, dog walk, teeter) and 12 weave poles. It is recommended that students have 12 weave poles and at least one contact obstacle at home for daily practice.
<b>Agility Sequencing Class</b>	6 weeks	\$85	6	Foundation & Groundwork, Jump Training, Contacts & Weaves	3/07/12 @6:30pm 7/11/12 @6:30	1 year and up	This class will allow you to put your groundwork and your obstacle training all together so that you can run with your dogs through agility courses. You will learn about common patterns of obstacle sequences, while putting your handling to good use.
