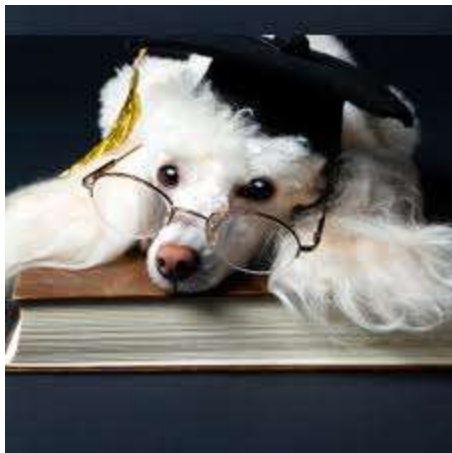


Sign up for PUPPY KINDERGARTEN NOW!!
