

## Upcoming Class Schedule

**Puppy Kindergarten Class-** 4 Weeks. (Open to all healthy puppies less than 20 weeks old) starts Wednesday November 30<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. Cost is \$75.00

**Basic Dog Training Class- 7 Weeks-** Starts Tuesday, January 10<sup>th</sup> at 7pm. Cost is \$165.00

**Dog Agility Confidence Course-** 4 Weeks. Use this class to “test” your puppy or dog to see if it would like agility or use the class for building confidence in a fearful dog. Basic obstacles will be gradually introduced including tunnel, chute, table, A-frame and dogwalk. Class starts Wednesday November 30<sup>th</sup> at 7:45pm. Class is limited to 6 dogs. Cost is \$55.00.

**Foundation & Groundwork for Dog Agility** - 8 weeks. (This class is a pre-requisite for all other upper level Agility Classes) Puppies and Adult dogs of all ages are eligible. No previous training is required. Class Starts Thursday, January 12<sup>th</sup> and 6:30pm. Class is limited to 6 dogs. Cost is \$100.00.

### ASCA Herding Trial DEBUTS for Cyndy, Riff, & June produce AWESOME Results!!



Cyndy Douan has attended herding clinics and herding lessons on and off for nearly 9 years. For that long, her herding partner has been Riff; until June came along and was ready to start learning to herd a few years ago. Now that Riff and June’s youngsters the “Jiffy Pups” have come along and gotten started on herding, a few of Cyndy’s friends and students began rallying for Cyndy to try out Riff & June at herding trials. Cyndy entered Riff & June in two different days of herding trials, once on October 30<sup>th</sup>, and again on November 6<sup>th</sup>. On October 30<sup>th</sup>, Riff earned his “Started Ducks” title with a 1<sup>st</sup> place & a 3<sup>rd</sup> place, and June

earned a 2<sup>nd</sup> Place in Started Ducks. On November 6<sup>th</sup>, June earned her Started Ducks title with a First Place, plus June won a rosette for Highest Score in Started. June also earned a 1<sup>st</sup> Place in Open Ducks.

Riff earned his Started Sheep Title with two 2<sup>nd</sup> Places, and he earned his Open Duck Title with a 1<sup>st</sup> Place & a 2<sup>nd</sup> Place (beaten only by June in ducks on that day!). Riff also earned a Rosette for Highest Score in Open, PLUS Riff won an award for High Combined Non-Aussie! Here are pictures of their herding awards. Go Riff & June!!!
